Pursuant to the New HR methodology for induction of Agriveerveyu under 'Agripath Scheme', aimed to provide an opportunity to Nation's youth to experience military way of life for a period of four years, <u>Indian Air Ferce invites ONLNE application from unmarried Indian male and female candidates for selection test from 13 October 2023 onwards to Join the IAF as an AGNIVEERVAYU.</u> The number and employability of female candidates will be decided as per service requirement.

(THE SELECTION TEST IS NOT FOR SELECTION AS COMMISSIONED OFFICERS/ PILOTS/ NAVIGATORS)

- Application is required to be filled only ONLINE by the candidates and detailed instructions to fill up the same are available at https://agnipathyayu.cdac.in.
- 3. This examination is valid for AGNIVEERVAYU INTAKE 01/2024.
- ONLINE REGISTRATION shall commence at 1000h on 27 July 2023 and will close at 2300h on 17 August 2023. Only ONLINE REGISTERED applications shall be accepted. For registration log on to https://iagnip.ath/vayu.cdac.in

Note: - Candidates are advised to register at the earliest opportunity as no extension of registration dates will be accommodated.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

5. Age.

- (a) Date of Birth Block. Candidate born between 27 June 2003 and 27 December 2006 (both dates inclusive) are eligible to apply.
- In case, a candidate clears all the stages of the Selection Procedure, then the upper age limit as on date of enrolment should be
- 6. Marital Status and Pregnancy. Only unmarried candidates (male & female) will be eligible for enrolment as Agniveen/vayu and they shall undertake not to many during the defined engagement period of four years. Keeping in view limited period of engagement of Agniveen/vayu inclusive of training, skill development activities, practical as well as formative assessment and organisational requirement of continuous service of Agniveen/vayu during the engagement period will adversely affect the operational efficiency of the Indian Air Forca. Agriveen/vayu who marry during the said period shall be discharged from the service. Further, only unmarried Agriveen/vayu will be eligible for selection in regular ractive as imman. Female candidates additionally shall be required to undertake not to get pregnant until engagement period. Such women Agriveen/vayu on becoming Low Medical Category (LMC) due to pregnancy shall be table to be discharged from service. Pregnancy will debut the women Agriveen/vayu for selection in regular Cadre. At the time of enrolment, candidates shall require to sign a voluntary undertaking accepting above conditions*.

Educational Qualification

(a) Science Subjects

Candidates should have passed intermediate/10+2/ Equivalent examination with Mathematics, Physics and English from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

Passed Two years Vocational Course with non-vocational subject viz, Physics and Mathematics from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Vocational Course (or in Intermediate / Matriculation, if English is not a subject in Vocational Course).

(b) Other than Science Subjects

Passed Informediate / 10+2 / Equivalent Examination in any stream/subjects from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

Passed two years Vocational Course from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Vocational Course (or in Intermediate / Matriculation if English is not a subject in Vocational Course).

Note - 1: Candidates eligible for Science Subjects examination (including Intermediate/ 10+2/three years' diploma course in engineering or two
years' vocational course with non-vocational subjects of Physics and Maths) are also eligible for Other than Science Subjects and would be given

Mandatory Medical Standards. General Medical Standards for AGNIVEERVAYU male & female candidates are as follows:

- - For Male candidates: Minimum acceptable height is 152.5 cms.
 - For Female candidates: Minimum acceptable height is 152 cme. For candidates belonging to North East or hilly regions of althand, a lower minimum height of 147 cms will be accepted. In case of candidates from Lakshadweep, the minimum height will be

Note: Candidates availing height relaxation for being domicile of North EastHilly Regions of Ultarakhand/Lakhadweep are to submit domicile certificate with endorsement of domicile status at the time of Phase-II testing, Further, candidates from hilly regions of Ultarakhand must have specific endorsement of hilly region that of domicile certificate.

- (d) Hearing: Candidate should have normal hearing i.e. able to hear forced whisper from a distance of 6 meters by each ear separ
- (e) Dental: Should have healthy gums, good set of teeth and minimum 14 dental points.

(g) Corneal Surgery (PRK/LASIK) is not acceptable.

Candidates should bring prescription and spectacles for corrected vision, if used. The latest prescription should contain dioprement, Ophthalmologist's registration number, stamp, signature and date of prescription should be within a month prior to appea

- (h) General Health: Candidate should be of normal anatomy without loss of any appendages. He / She should be free from any active or latent, acute or chronic, medical or surgical disability or communicable disease, infection and skin aliments. Candidate shall be physically and mentally FIT to perform duty in any part of the world, in any climate and terrain.
- Gynaecological Examination (For female candidates): The examination covers external genitalia, hernia orifices and the perineum, any dence of stress urinary incontinence or genital prolapse outside introllus.

- (ii) Gender (For female candidates): Any candidate if found to have predominant characteristics of the opposite gender as evident on external physical examination, will be rejected as Unifit. Any candidate having undergone gender reassignment surgery will be declared Unifie.
- Pregnancy (For female candidates): Any candidate, if found to be pregnant shall be disqualified and her candidature

- Consumption of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance (NDPS). Consumption of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic incest banned under the NDPS Act 1995 shall be a reject criteria for selection into the IAF. AGNIVEEXYAYU found either in sisten or storing or distributing or consuming such drugs and substances after enrolment shall be liable for disciplinary action including seal from the IAF. ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY TO ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE IS FOLLOWED IN IAF.
- 0. <u>Body Tattoo.</u> Permanent body tattoos are not permitted, however, tattoos only on inner face of the fore arms (inside of ebow to the rist), back (dorsal) part of the hand/everes alide of the pain and Tribals with tattoo which are as per the custom and traditions of their tribes may be considered. Offensive, obscere, indicent, sessior a rost tattoos are prohibited regardless of location on the body. However, fight occnsider tattoo acceptable or unacceptable will rest with the selection centre. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 12. Agriveenayu will be enrolled in the Indian Air Force under Air Force Act 1950, for a period of FOUR years. Agriveenayu would form a distinct rank in the Indian Air Force, different from any other existing ranks. The Indian Air Force is not obliged to retain Agriveenayu beyond the engagement prior of four years.
- On completion of four years of service, based on organisation's requirements and policies promulgated by the Indian Air Force, servays will be offered an opportunity to apoly for enrolment in the regular cader of the Indian Air Force as Airman. These applications will be retend in a centralised manner based on objective critical, including performance during their four-year engagement period and up to 25% of specific batch of Agriveenveys will be enrolled in regular caders of IA². Again everysis will not have any right to be selected for further next into the Indian Air Force. Selection of the Agniveenveys for further enrollment, if any, shall be at the discretion of the memert of India.
- Employability. Agniveervayu enrolled under this entry are liable to be assigned any duty in organisational interest at the dis Indian Air Force.
- Training. On being enrolled, Agniveervayu will be imparted military training based on Indian Air Force requir
- Leave. Grant of leave will be subject to exigencies of the Indian Air Force. The following leave is applicable for Agniveer
 - (a) Annual Leave. 30 days per year.
 - (b) Sick Leave. Based on medical advice
- Medical and CSD Facilities. For the duration of their engagement period in the Indian Air Force, Agniveervayu will be entitled for medical facility at Service Hospitals as well as CSD provisions.
- Pay. Allowances and Allied Benefits. Agriveervayu enrolled under this Scheme will be paid an Agriveer package of Rs. 30,000 eth a fixed yearly increment. In addition, Risk and Hardship allowances (as applicable in IAF), Dress and Travel allowances will be other seriod, colling, accommodation and Leaver Travello paid allowances (as applicable in IAF). Dress and Travel allowances will be other seriod, colling, accommodation and Leaver Travello paid consession (LTC) shall also be provided as per the sisting rules.
- <u>Terminal Benefits Sava Nidhl Package.</u> AGNIVEERVAYU will be given one time "Sava Nidhl" package comprising their monthly ulion along with matching contribution by the Government on completion of their engagement period, as indicated below.

- Note 2: There shall be no entitlement to gratuity and any kind of pensionary benefits
- 20. Insurance. Death and Disability Compensation. AGNINEERVAYU will be provided non-contributory Life insurance cover of Rs. 48 Labra for the duration of their engagement period as AGNIVEERVAYU in the Indian Air Force. - 23. <u>Online Test</u>. Eligible candidates will be sent provisional admit cards for Phase I of testing on their registered e-mail IDs between 48-72 he prior to the examination. Candidates are required to download the admit card, take a colour printout and carry the same to the examination centre. Name of city & scand date will be intimated to candidates at an earlier date to enable them to plan their movement. This provisional admit card can also be downloaded by the candidate under candidates boin on CASB web portal <a href="https://downloads.inchediates/name="h
- (a) <u>Science Subjects</u>. Total duration of the online test shall be <u>60 minutes</u> and shall comprise of Physics, <u>Mat</u> English as per 10+2 CBSE syllabus.
- (b) Other than Science Subjects. Total duration of the online test shall be 45 minutes and shall comprise of English as per 10+2 CBSE syllabus and Reasoning & General Awareness (RAGA).
- Science Subjects & Other than Science Subjects. Total duration of the online test shall be 85 minutes and shall comprise of s, Mathematics and English as per 10+2 CBSE sylabus and Reasoning & General Awareness (RAGA).
- - One mark for every correct answer
 - Nil (0) marks for unattempted question
 - 0.25 marks shall be deducted for each wrong answer

- Note: Above examination methodology has been designed to facilitate selection process based on qualifications of candidat irrespective of the examination methodology AGNIVEERVAYU enrolled under this entry are liable to be assigned any duty in organisation interest, at the discretion of the Indian AF proce.
- Marks scored by the candidates in STAR Phase-I Testing will be "Normalised" by using the formula as published on the web site (aconpathenyu.cdscin. to take into account variation in difficulty levels of the question papers across different sessions. Candidates are to take the application of QuCM for shortisting candidates for STAR Phase-II testing and preparation of Final Ment List for selection will be on "Normalsed Marks" and not on the "Actual Marks" scored by the candidate in STAR Phase-I testing. Further, on normalisation, marks by a candidate in a subject may become less/more than actual marks, and more than total marks of that subject in exceptional cases.
- CANDIDATES ARE TO QUALIFY IN EACH PAPER INDIVIDUALLY IN SCIENCE SUBJECTS AND OTHER THAN SCIENCE ECTS, with normalised marks. - 27. <u>Additional Skilla/Qualifications/Achievements</u>. Candidates with any additional skills / qualifications / achievements in fields, including not limited to, Information Technology, Motor Vehicle driving / maintenance, Hospitality, Logistics, Accounting, Catering, Westing, Typing Sports etc. are required to upload supporting cartificates / documents through a link provided along with Phase-II call letter and also kunish the time of Phase-II testing, Candidates are encouraged to acquire additional skills to have an edge in their performance during training
- 28. <u>Verification of Eligibility.</u> Candidates should be in possession of the documents mentioned at para 26 & 27 above, when appearing for the selection test which would be scrutinised/verified prior to commencement of Phase-II to ascertain the eligibility prima-facile. Detailed verification of all the documents listed at para 26 & 27 above shall be carried out in respect of candidates who pass Adaptability Test 1. - Adaptability Test-II. All candidates who pass Adaptability Test-I shall have to undertake Adaptability Test-II as per policy in vogulability Test-II is to select candidates who can adapt to the environment of the Indian Air Force and are able to adjust to the military way of life.

Candidates declared medically unfit can avail the option for 'Appeal Medical Board' (AMB) against their unfitness by depositing Rs. 400- in a Government Treasury/RB/ISBI through Electronic Milliary Raceivable Order (e-J-RCO) / Milliary Raceivable Order (eJ-RCO) in Milliary Raceivable Order (eJ-RCO

- The recruitment medical officer and the specialist doctors of Armed Forces are the final authorities on declaring a candidate fit or unfit till medical examination, appeal medical board and medical examination prior to enrolment. The candidates shall be governed by Armed andards which may be at variance from civil standards. There is no provision for representation or review after the appeal medical board.
